

HOW OFTEN DO YOU USE METRO SERVICES?




IF YOU ARE NOT A CURRENT METRO CUSTOMER, WHAT WOULD ENCOURAGE YOU TO USE METRO?

- I am unaware of stops in Twinsburg and have just become aware of service to Akron and Cleveland. If I knew of the services available I may be more apt to use them


IF YOU ARE NOT A CURRENT METRO CUSTOMER, WHAT WOULD ENCOURAGE YOU TO USE METRO?

- I would use a train.


WHAT METRO SERVICES, IF ANY, HAVE YOU USED IN THE PAST YEAR?




FOR WHAT PURPOSES DO YOU USE METRO?




WHICH AREAS IN THE REGION SHOULD BE MORE ACCESSIBLE BY TRANSIT?

- Son't use transit for cultural/sporting events because service does not run late enough. Consider more express services in Summit County. Transit message board to departures/arrivals.

- I think this is a very good idea that they're trying to make something new happen in Akron. I am very excited.
- More frequent run times for buses.
- I was really impressed with the service display at Chapel Hill Mall. Excellent and the gentleman who answered my question impressed me also.
- Solution
 Light rail connecting the GCRTA system to Akron, CAK and Canton

SAMPLE RESPONSES:

Suild a transit backbone with a train line that stops in the Valley and can connect up to Hudson/Macedonia and commuter down to Canton. Stops at CAK, Goodyear, Northside, CF, why not a stop in Kent as well.. This would allow more people to travel freely to places they want to go and live without needing a car. A BRT to Summit Mall wouldn't be a bad idea from Northside. Put a half cent sales tax levy up for a vote to test the waters with the public to implement train service.

- Serve outside of Summit County especially the border areas of Cuyahoga AND/OR have a reciprocal relationship with the RTA if traveling to Cleveland to have bus routes and times coordinated if a rider needs to use both services,
- I use the SCAT service for my medical appointments in Akron & the price is affordable for retirees at this time. The SCAT service is excellent & I have no complaints.


SAMPLE RESPONSES:

If you make the stops and units (buses, etc) look better (similar to GCRTA Euclid corridor) more middle income riders will follow. Additionally more innovative transit concepts such as BRT, and streetcars would pull more people (such as tourists) to the system. Also if Metro would find a developer to develop TODs near the city center, or even in areas such as Firestone Park, and Goodyear Heights which were once transit oriented I believe that it would be positive not only for Metro but the greater Akron area.



IN WHAT METRO DEPARTMENT DO YOU WORK?





- More Park & Ride lots in outlying suburbs going into Akron.



- I live on a bus line and would if something happened to my car.


WHICH OF THESE DO YOU CONSIDER TO BE THE GREATEST THREAT TO METRO RIDERSHIP?




WHICH OF THESE DO YOU CONSIDER TO BE METRO'S BEST ASSET FOR FUTURE RIDERSHIP GROWTH?
